

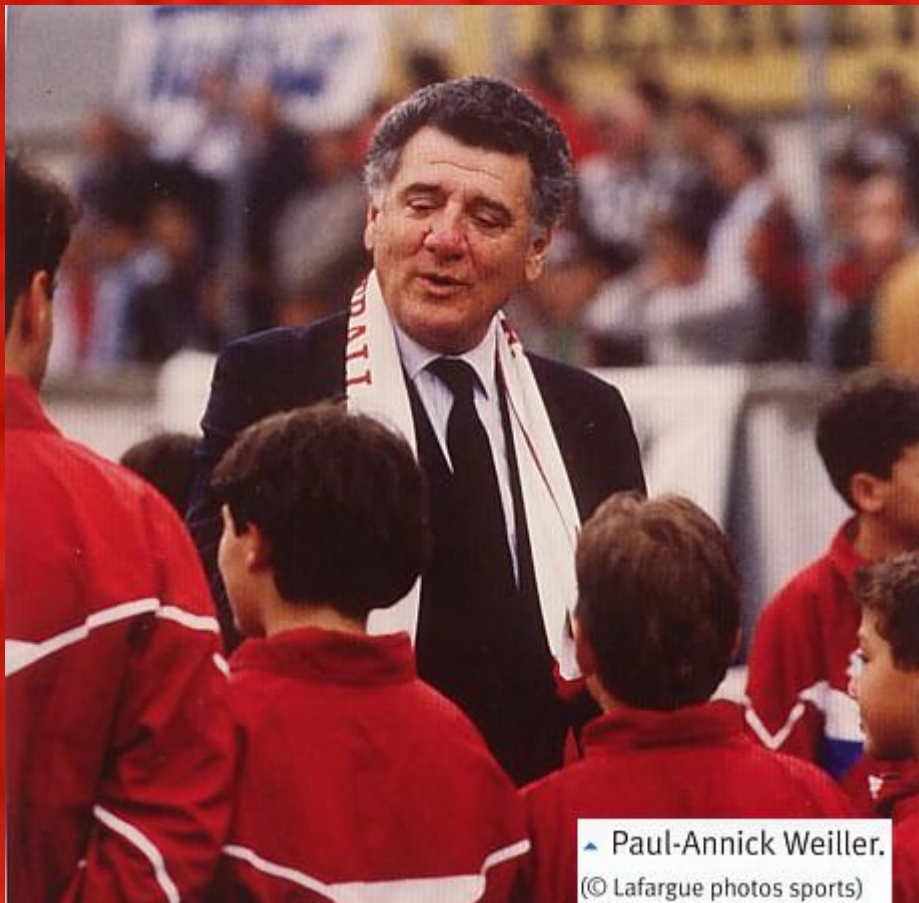

Obituary: Paul-Annik Weiller

THERE WERE 25 square metres of flowers at the funeral of Paul-Annik Weiller in Geneva last week. Friends flew from as far as Mexico and Florida, while Servette, the football club he saved for Switzerland, was there in force. Much-loved and a highly successful international businessman, he succeeded in remaining largely unknown to the world's press or public.

Paul-Annik Weiller was born on 28 July 1933 at Paris, France. He is the son of Paul Louis Weiller and Alikí Diplarakos. He married Olympia Torlonia, daughter of Alessandro Torlonia, 5th Principe de Civitella-Cessi and Beatriz Isabel Frederica Alfonsa de Borbón y Battenberg, Infanta de España, on 16 June 1965 at Rome, Italy. He died November 1998.
